Owners Terry & Joanie Thuemling from New Berlin, Wisconsin will be featuring their all-steel reproduction of the very desirable 1932 Ford Roadster called a Dearborn Deuce. Built by Timeless Rod and Custom in Atlanta Georgia, the Deuce was a 3-year build and was completed in 2009. After being in storage for 6 years from the previous owner's health issue, Terry purchased the Ford in 2017 and began some much-needed upgrades and modifications.

Chassis & Suspension: Heldts superride independent suspension, chrome upper and lower control arms and coil over shocks, polished rack & pinion steering, Chip Foose wheels and Wilwood disc brakes.

Exterior: All steel reproduction body from Dearborn Michigan with fiberglass fenders painted a magnificent Candy Apple Red PPG Vibrance Liquid Crystal, unique pop-up gas tank filler in the trunk, hidden door handles, louvered side hoods, custom tulip panel behind seat to store Haartz cloth top.

Interior: All of the interior is custom built to fit, remote entry, custom gages, tan leather, custom center console, stainless steel steering column with a vintage tachometer, LeCarra chrome steering wheel with matching leather and custom bucket seats.

Awards/Special Recognition: Milwaukee World of Wheels Best in Class, Best Paint and Best Display in 2020, Sponsors Pick at The Cars That Time Forgot in Delevan in 2018, Top Show winner in multiple shows in Florida and Wisconsin.

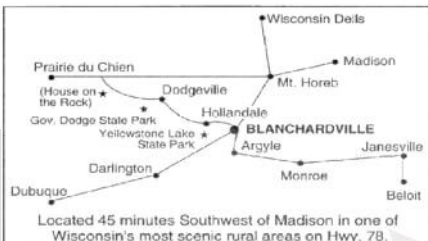

Dwight & Ashley Anderson from Blue Mounds Wisconsin will be featuring their numbers matching, complete rotisserie restored 1970 Dodge Super Bee. The car was documented to originally be sold in Plover Wisconsin and was later sold to a collector in Detroit, then one in New Hampshire before Dwight brought the Super Bee back home to Wisconsin. It was restored by Magnum Restorations in LaSalle Illinois. Opel Engineering of Streamwood Illinois rebuilt the 440 6 pack with matching VIN numbers. It has won Concourse Gold at the Muscle Car and Corvette Nationals with 977/1000 points and the Mopar Nationals with 518/520 points and is probably the most detailed correct 1970 Super Bee on the planet!
